**SESSION #1**  
**6/17-6/21**

Exploring Mother Goose's Rhymes – Introduction and overview of some of the most treasured stories. Mother Goose is on the loose, searching behind every spruce for favorite rhymes from her stories. We'll make time for every rhyme!

**SESSION #2**  
**6/24-6/28**

The Three Little Pigs, Mother Hubbard and Humpty Dumpty – The Three little Pigs were not the best builders, Mother Hubbard was not the best shopper, and Humpty Dumpty was pretty darn fragile, yet these characters and stories continue to fascinate us. We'll take a fresh look at why they do.

**SESSION #3**  
**7/1-7/5**

Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Bears and Jack and Jill – We always remember Little Red Riding Hood's outfit, an uncomfortable bed is sure to bring The Three Bears to mind, and who can go up a hill without thinking of Jack and Jill? We revisit these stories and why they come to mind so often.

**SESSION #4**  
**7/8-7/12**

Alice In Wonderland – we follow the White Rabbit down the hole to journey into Alice’s Wonderland. We’ll catch up with the Queen of Hearts, Cheshire Cat, Caterpillar, and lots of other special characters along the way.

**SESSION #5**  
**7/15-19**

Hansel and Gretel, Mr. McGregor’s Garden and the Frog and Princess – be ready to drop breadcrumbs as we journey into Hansel and Gretel’s world. From there, Peter Rabbit takes us to McGregor’s Garden where we find out it’s best not to take vegetables from someone else’s garden. We wrap up around the wishing well to see Mr. Frog and help the Princess find the golden ball.

**SESSION #6**  
**7/22-7/26**

King Arthur’s Castle – we cross the drawbridge to enter the world of King Arthur and his knights. As we gather in the castle at the round table, we’ll be transported back to life in medieval times.

All sessions will include interactive walk/play through Storyland’s exhibits. Activities such as scavenger hunts, math, science, art lessons, crafts, music and movement and reading activities. All books and supplies will be provided for each student. Snacks will also be provided.
